#### ...from Fr. Gerard

#### I can do all things in him who strengthens me.

"I can't do it." How many times have you given up? How many times have you lost confidence in yourself? How many times have you stopped believing in your abilities? My guess is that the answer most of us would give to the above questions is "often." There are so many reasons to be discouraged or to just give up on our dreams and hopes. The reality is we have successes and failures in life—sometimes without any effort or fault of our own. A failure or an obstacle does not necessarily mean we can't do something. What it may mean is that we need a strength or a motivation that comes from beyond our abilities.

In spiritual life, we pursue not simply our own plan, but we allow ourselves to be directed, often in a way that we do not want to go. "I can't do that," more often, is really "I won't do that." Fear is the emotion that most often causes us to believe that something is impossible.


But what if it is not about me or what I want? If God is truly calling us to something, will God not provide us with the ability to do so? I don't hold myself up as an example of self-confidence by any means, but I do know that many accomplishments have occurred because it has been the abilities that God has bestowed on me. My own vocation of priesthood has provided me with many examples of what has been done by him who strengthens me.

So, to what is it that you keep saying "I can't?" Is it a career advancement, a relationship, a health improvement, a religious vocation, seeking forgiveness or an act of mercy? Instead of saying "I can't," let us replace that phrase with another that is just as familiar, "thy will be done." When we say these words in the Lord's Prayer, we are surrendering the personal concept of "I can't," and accepting that, with the Lord, all things are possible. I can't but you can, O Lord, and may your will be done through and with all of us who place our hope in you.

**PRAYERS FOR AND SOLIDARITY WITH THE HOLY LAND** —. What may at first have been perceived as another moment in the ongoing tensions between the Israeli government and Palestinian people has clearly been revealed as one of history's most barbaric terrorist attacks. The number of lives lost is staggering, and the acts of the inhumane slaughter of innocent civilians are inconceivable.

On Tuesday evening, I was invited to represent the Catholic Church at the Nassau County rally in support of Israel. It was an extremely moving and passionate experience. Among the thousands present were those whose families were living amidst the violence. I was honored to stand with other faith leaders, particularly those in the Jewish community, and offer them the solidarity of our Catholic community. I encourage you to unite your prayers with our Jewish brothers and sisters on Long Island and all the people in the Holy Land.
