...from Fr. Gerard

I have called you by your name, giving you a title, though you knew me not.

Throughout this Respect Life Month, we continue to reflect on the truth that every human being is made in the image and likeness of God. Even further, the prophet Isaiah tells us that each one of us bears a special name known only by God. We, therefore, profess and believe that God creates unique persons with a personality, soul, and character shared by no one else. At no point in our lives do we lose our unique personhood or soul.

The singular importance of every life is at the core of the terror and war raging in Israel and the Palestinian territory of the Gaza Strip. This conflict began with acts of vicious and barbaric attacks on innocent human life. Responding with worthy punishment is justly called for. Protection of the innocent, however, is also of the highest concern. Allowing for safe passage from danger, provisioning for water and food, and the providing of medical care are the required and just actions owed to the individual dignity and life of innocent individuals.

In the classic novel, *To Kill a Mockingbird*, the protagonist, Atticus Finch, declares, "You never really understand a person until you consider things from his point of view...until you climb into his skin and walk around in it." Life is complex. It is not always easy to consider another point of view, especially when an alternative point of view is not just, is unreasonable, and disrespects the unique dignity of another person. Our everyday life is much simpler and not as complex as global conflicts. Yet we allow anxiety caused by a great evil, such as this, to impact the way we speak of and treat others.

We owe it to those who are enduring true evil to first and foremost be in solidarity with them in prayer and in action. Secondly, when human dignity is violated and under attack, we can't let the power of evil overcome us in the ordinary. With all our hope, we pray for a peaceful end to the horrors taking place in the Holy Land. And we pray that the virtues of patience and compassion increase within us, so that evil may have no power over us.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION – This week we welcome Auxiliary Bishop Robert Coyle and retired Auxiliary Bishop John Dunne to our parish for the conferral of the Sacrament of Confirmation on our young parishioners. Most of the candidates are high school freshmen who have completed catechetical preparation at our school or in our Faith Formation program. Over the last two months, they participated in a communal celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, an evening of prayer and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and a Sponsor and Candidate evening of reflection. They now count on your prayers as they complete their Christian Initiation and begin their discipleship of the Lord as members of His church.
