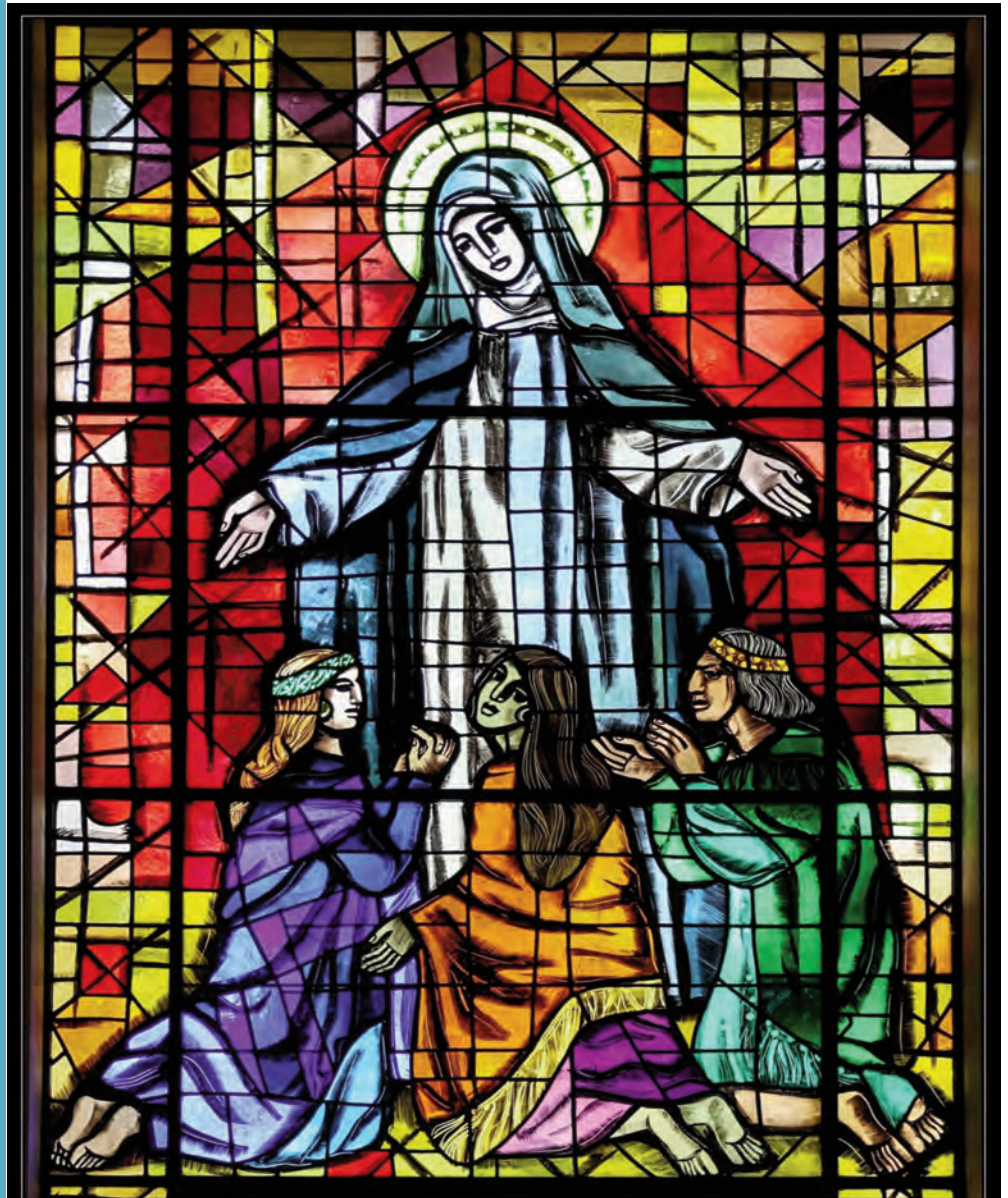

...from Fr. Gerard

Whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

In the Letter to the Philippians, St. Paul tells us that, as God's people, we are called to think upon all that is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, gracious, and worthy of praise. It would be quite interesting for us to brainstorm what comes to our minds when we think of these qualities. But can there be any doubt as to the answer that God himself would offer? Genesis chapter 1, verse 27 says this "So God created humankind in his image, in the image of God he created them; male and female, he created them." In the eyes of God, it is the human person, made in his image and likeness, who personifies these characteristics found most perfectly in God himself. As the Son of God, Jesus Christ teaches that loving one another as He loves us, especially those who are the least among us, is worthy of the Father's praise.

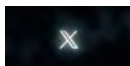
St. Paul says that when we have this perspective in our dealings with others, we will experience a "peace of God that surpasses all understanding," a peace that keeps all anxiety at bay and "guards our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." All of us desire that kind of interior peace. Our lives tend to be turbulent and stormy, in one way or another, but in our hearts, we long for depth, peace, and stability. Being a person of mercy and goodness can give that peace to us. If we show mercy to others, our hearts mysteriously open up to God's mercy, which he is always pouring out on us. But if we don't show mercy to others, it's like we put an umbrella over our own hearts, and God's transforming mercy just glides right off. Mercy isn't about forgiving others because they deserve to be forgiven. Mercy is forgiving precisely when they don't deserve it because that's how God forgives us.

IRA Charitable Rollover Qualified Charitable Distribution

If you would like to make a gift to St. Rose using your IRA, you can if:

1. On the date you make the gift, you are at least 70 ½ years old*
2. Your IRA is a traditional (some Roth IRA's may qualify), and
3. You don't exceed your personal maximum of \$100,000 per year in qualified charitable distributions.

(*A Qualified Charitable Distribution can be made after 70½ even if you are not subject to Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) yet. Speak with your tax specialist about new IRS rules on when you must take your RMD.)

You will not have to report your distribution as income. It will be free of Federal and New York State income tax, and it will count toward your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).

This is a unique opportunity to make a charitable contribution through a direct IRA transfer while reducing your adjusted gross income.

The best way for you to start is with your IRA custodian. Tell them you want to make a “qualified charitable distribution.” In most cases, you will only have to fill out a simple form.

VERY IMPORTANT: Your gift must go directly from your IRA to our Parish. If you receive the money first, you will be taxed on it like any other distribution.



WHAT IT TAKES TO MAKE A QCD



The QCD must come from a Traditional or Inherited IRA.



Beneficiary must be at least 70 ½.



The distribution must go directly to a qualified charity.



You must receive a confirmation letter from the charity that states no goods or services were received in exchange for the contribution.

We began by diving into the delightful story "The Dot" by Peter H. Reynolds, which inspired our little artists to unleash their creativity.

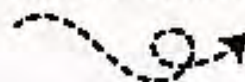

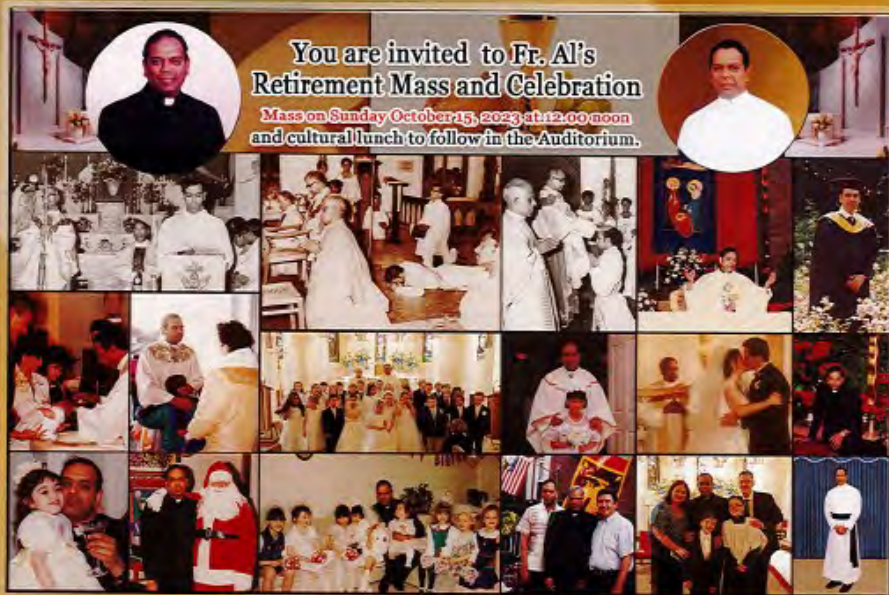
