

Fr. Ken's Corner

Dear St. Rose of Lima Family,

It's that time of the year again when we look to the future by looking at the past. As you read this week's bulletin, you will discover our Annual Financial Report. I invite you to look at all the information and schedules as carefully as you would look at your own monthly statements.

As always, I wish to thank each and every person and family who has supported St. Rose of Lima this past year with your generous financial donations and contributions of time and talent. Although we may think primarily of being present to our fellow parishioners through our prayers and worship, your financial support from our weekly offertory collections and the Catholic Ministries Appeal plays a critical role in the daily works of our priests, deacons, School, Faith Formation program, Parish Social Ministry, music, CYO, parish staff and countless ministries in the joy of preaching the message of the gospel. Active participation by so many families in our grade level masses, great enthusiasm for our recent music concerts and the abundance of generosity offered for those in need for Thanksgiving are just a few examples where we witness faith in action.

In thanking you for your support with the donations you have entrusted to us, I am also happy to thank our Business Manager, Trustees, and Finance Committee for their expertise and guidance. Please do not hesitate to ask us any financial questions you may have.

As an update, I am glad to say that within the next few weeks, work on the **garage** roof will begin. This work isn't very visible, but it is necessary to prevent future structural damage. We are able to begin this project due to your enthusiastic response to the Roofing Appeal presented to you this summer. Funds received approximate \$70,000. Work on the replacement of the **rectory** roof will commence in the late spring of 2020. Look for future updates regarding this project.

In addition, thanks to the generosity of CYO and two generous benefactors, we have been able to finish a long-awaited project for this year, our electronic sign. This sign brings greater awareness of all that is happening at St. Rose as well as offering hopeful and inspiring messages.

Of great significance this year has been the August 2019 passing of the Child Victim's Act in New York, allowing, until August 2020, an unlimited look-back period for victims of sexual abuse to file claims. In this difficult and uncertain time, we continue to pray for those who have suffered abuse. As we honor our Blessed Mother Mary tomorrow in celebrating the Solemnity of her Immaculate Conception (not a Holy Day of Obligation this year), let us ask for her prayers and protection. Our faithful have always turned to Mary for her prayerful assistance.



Meaning & Symbolism of Poinsettias

What is the meaning of poinsettias? Also known as the Christmas Star and Christmas Flower, it's said that poinsettias' association with Christmas comes from a Mexican legend. The story goes that a child, with no means for a grander gift, gathered humble weeds from the side of the road to place at the church altar on Christmas Eve. As the congregation witnessed a Christmas miracle, the weeds turned into brilliant red and green flowers.

The shape of the poinsettia flower and leaves are sometimes thought of as a symbol of the Star of Bethlehem which led the Wise Men to Jesus. The red-colored leaves symbolize the blood of Christ. The white leaves represent his purity.
