

...from Fr. Gerard

If you are patient when you suffer for doing what is good, this is a grace before God.

Patience, as the saying goes, is a virtue. What is a virtue? The Catechism of the Catholic Church says this. "A virtue is a habitual and firm disposition to do the good. It allows the person not only to perform good acts, but to give the best of himself. The virtuous person tends toward the good with all his sensory and spiritual powers; he pursues the good and chooses it in concrete actions." [CCC 1803] A virtue reflects what is perfect in God. Regarding patience, we remember these words from Psalm 103, verse 8, "Merciful and gracious is the LORD, slow to anger, abounding in mercy." God is patient. Patience, the church teaches, is a fruit of the Holy Spirit, meaning that patience is a product of our relationship with the Holy Spirit.

A virtue is the desire and the willingness to do good in all things, and the fruit of patience is a result of the grace of the Holy Spirit perfecting that desire. This is what St. Peter means when he speaks in the second reading today. If we desire to do good amidst suffering or, even more so, desire that our suffering brings about a good, God's grace produces that fruit of patience.

It is my prayer that I can bear the fruit of patience, as it is something with which I often struggle. Whether it be waiting for the light to turn green or with the missteps of another person, I am often guilty of losing patience. Let us desire what we can gain by the grace of the Holy Spirit, fruits like patience.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS – This Sunday marks the 60th Anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. The purpose of World Day of Prayer for Vocations is to publicly fulfill the Lord's instruction to, "Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest." (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2) As a climax to a prayer that is continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and to the consecrated life. While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate), consecrated life in all its forms (male and female religious life, societies of apostolic life, consecrated virginity), secular institutes in their diversity of services and membership, and to the missionary life.

Michelangelo Buonarroti is said to have maintained that every block of stone contains a statue within it, and it is up to the sculptor to uncover it. If that is true of an artist, how much more is it true of God! In the young woman of Nazareth, he saw the Mother of God. In Simon the fisherman, he saw Peter, the rock on which he would build his Church. In the publican Levi, he recognized the apostle and evangelist Matthew, and in Saul, a harsh persecutor of Christians, he saw Paul, the apostle of the Gentiles. God's loving gaze always meets us, touches us, sets us free and transforms us, making us into new persons.

That is what happens in every vocation: we are met by the gaze of God who calls us. Vocation, like holiness, is not an extraordinary experience reserved for a few. Just as there is a "holiness of the saints next door" (cf. Gaudete et Exsultate, 6-9), so, too, there is a vocation for everyone, for God's gaze and call is directed to every person.

Let us pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, societies of apostolic life or secular institutes.
