

(St. John Paul II, Dominicae cenae, no. 3) Eucharist "makes present the one "It is called: Eucharist, sacrifice of Christ the because it is an action of Savior." (CCC, no. 1330) thanksgiving to God." Before we return to Ordinary Time Sundays, we celebrate one more Solemnity of the Lord, The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We are a Eucharistic faith. Our life as a community of faith is celebrated in communion with the Lord and the rest of the Body at the altar of sacrifice. The Eucharist is what unites us, nourishes us, and, most certainly, identifies us. Without the Eucharist, we are not Church, and we are not united with Jesus Christ and his sacrifice. It is for this reason that we have an obligation to attend mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. While each of us must cultivate our personal spiritual life, we cannot live our faith through private prayer and devotion alone. We need the Eucharist; we need the abiding presence of Christ within us.

This Sunday, following our 10:00 am Family Mass, our parish will participate in a Eucharistic procession around the church. While we may be familiar with various walks which raise money for a particular cause, we may not be as familiar with a Eucharistic Procession (or walk). In a Eucharistic Procession, we take Christ out into the world, and by our witness, we pray that others may seek to know Jesus Christ and his church. I thank everyone who will participate in our procession today, helping to bring attention to the Eucharist and how it is so central to our faith.

In honor of today's feast and the National Eucharistic revival, I invite you to make a spiritual Eucharistic journey this summer. Instead of monetary pledges, I challenge you to obtain, from at least one person, a pledge to attend Mass every Sunday throughout the summer. In addition, I ask you to pray daily for those who do not attend Mass, that they return to the celebration of the Eucharist.

**WEARING OUR SUNDAY BEST** - This Sunday is also a good opportunity for us to revisit the question of appropriate dress for Mass. As we enter the summer season, we commit ourselves to wearing clothing that is appropriate and shows respect, both to the Lord and to those around us in our Church. Please remember that here in our Church, we come to meet the Lord and must present ourselves in His House with respect and reverence in the way we behave and how we dress.

WEEK OF ADORATION RETURNS – During the first week of Easter, we hosted extended hours of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Father Graham Center Chapel. That week was a tremendous success in terms of participation and spiritual fruit. Believe it or not, our Sunday mass attendance has increased since last year. I believe that the week of prayer was a significant cause of the rise in Sunday mass attendance. At the end of this month, we will hold another week of extended adoration. Please join us June 26 to June 30. Please see further information elsewhere in today's bulletin.

**PRIESTHOOD ORDINATIONS** - This Saturday, Bishop John O. Barres ordained three new priests for service in our diocese. Among them is **Father Steven McClernon** who just completed his diaconate assignment down the road at St. William the Abbot in Seaford. We congratulate Fr. 



# How Do I Request Prayer for myself or someone I love at St. Rose of Lima?

Our parish receives numerous prayer requests from parishioners, and non-parishioners, for a variety of needs, but mostly for those who are experiencing an illness. Following is a list of opportunities for prayer in our parish:

<u>Prayers for the sick from the pulpit and in our weekly bulletin</u>: Please call the rectory (516.798.4992) during regular business hours to add your name to this list. Names are mentioned from the pulpit during all Masses for one week, and are then transferred to the bulletin for a period of three weeks. (Please note: 1) For privacy reasons, if you are requesting prayers for someone other than yourself, you must have the permission of the person being prayed for to add their name to this list. 2) If a name is not announced, please know that they are not forgotten, as we pray for all those who are ill and convalescing at every Mass).

<u>Parish Prayer Intention Book:</u> A book is located in the church narthex by the statue of St. Rose of Lima, where you can write your prayer request. These prayers can be for any reason, including for those serving in the military, and will be included collectively in our Sunday and weekday Mass intentions.

<u>Charismatic Prayer Group prayer box</u>: There is a box located on the shelf in the church vestibule - the entrance from the parking lot by the sacristy door - where you can place your request for prayers. Each week, the members of the Charismatic Prayer Group check the box and the prayer requests are divided amongst the members. They will pray for your needs during their meeting on Wednesday afternoons, and continue at their homes. Paper and pencil are available by the prayer box for your convenience.

<u>Prayer Line Ministry</u>: Call or email (mariap@srolchurch.org) the rectory to request prayers. Members of this ministry receive a weekly list of names of people in need of prayer and pray for them in the privacy of their own home. Only first names are used to protect the privacy of the individual being prayed for.

**For the Military**: Call the rectory to request prayers for those serving in the military and we will print the person's name, and the branch they serve in, in the bulletin on a monthly basis.




