

...from Fr. Gerard

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

How incredible it is that two thousand years later, the priests greet the people at Mass with the very same words that St. Paul used in his written greeting to the people of Corinth? The priest and St. Paul greet, not in their own name, but in the name of the greater divine community of the Holy Trinity. It may seem like a strange thing to do, but can you imagine if we sincerely greeted each other in this way, rather than some of the informal (and sometimes vulgar) ways people greet each other. While we might feel awkward greeting each other in the name of the triune God, can we not at least challenge ourselves to raise our level of respect to each other, to at least realize that is what we are called to do? We are ambassadors of God's grace, fellowship, and love.

Greeting each other in this way is also a reminder that we, through our baptism, are incorporated into this sacred community of the Holy Trinity. Bishop Robert Barron, a well-known speaker and writer says:

"When you pray, you listen as the Father and Son talk about you. When we pray, we quiet ourselves enough so as to hear the Father and Son, in the Holy Spirit, talk about us."

Isn't that an awesome way to think about this mystery? Isn't that a profound and new way to understand prayer?

As we celebrate the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, we are not celebrating an event, which is what we commonly do on a feast day. Instead, we celebrate a reality, a mystery that is continually unfolding in our lives. God loves us as the Father who creates, the Son who saves and the Holy Spirit who consecrates us and unites us with this sacred community of love. When we make the sign of the cross, when we begin our prayer in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – we are seeking not to understand the mystery, but we are reminding ourselves that we live within the sacred reality, which is God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

How Do I Request Prayer for myself or someone I love at St. Rose of Lima?

Our parish receives numerous prayer requests from parishioners, and non-parishioners, for a variety of needs, but mostly for those who are experiencing an illness. Following is a list of opportunities for prayer in our parish:

<u>Prayers for the sick from the pulpit and in our weekly bulletin</u>: Please call the rectory (516.798.4992) during regular business hours to add your name to this list. Names are mentioned from the pulpit during all Masses for one week, and are then transferred to the bulletin for a period of three weeks. (Please note: 1) For privacy reasons, if you are requesting prayers for someone other than yourself, you must have the permission of the person being prayed for to add their name to this list. 2) If a name is not announced, please know that they are not forgotten, as we pray for all those who are ill and convalescing at every Mass).

<u>Parish Prayer Intention Book:</u> A book is located in the church narthex by the statue of St. Rose of Lima, where you can write your prayer request. These prayers can be for any reason, including for those serving in the military, and will be included collectively in our Sunday and weekday Mass intentions.

<u>Charismatic Prayer Group prayer box</u>: There is a box located on the shelf in the church vestibule - the entrance from the parking lot by the sacristy door - where you can place your request for prayers. Each week, the members of the Charismatic Prayer Group check the box and the prayer requests are divided amongst the members. They will pray for your needs during their meeting on Wednesday afternoons, and continue at their homes. Paper and pencil are available by the prayer box for your convenience.

<u>Prayer Line Ministry</u>: Call or email (mariap@srolchurch.org) the rectory to request prayers. Members of this ministry receive a weekly list of names of people in need of prayer and pray for them in the privacy of their own home. Only first names are used to protect the privacy of the individual being prayed for.

For the Military: Call the rectory to request prayers for those serving in the military and we will print the person's name, and the branch they serve in, in the bulletin on a monthly basis.


