...from Fr. Gerard

Do not conform yourselves to this age, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect.

A priest friend of mine offered a reaction to the following question: *"Why, when Jesus talks about feeding the poor, it's Christianity, but when a politician does it, it's Socialism?"* He answered in this way:

"Jesus encouraged us to use our resources to take care of those in need. It is a choice that one has to make. Certain politicians want to take from others to feed the poor. There is no conversion on the part of those whose resources are taken to feed others. There's certainly a difference between Christianity and socialism. There's a big difference between an act of the heart and an act of the law. While it may be the same result, the end doesn't always justify the means."

I found his words helpful after another dear friend of mine posted this on his social media account: *"If your Church is telling you how to vote...then your church should be paying taxes."*

I will save the debate on taxes for another day, but it is the presupposition that the church tells you how to vote that I will argue with here. As my friend Father Leo states above, the church is about the conversion of hearts. An act of the heart occurs when the Gospel preached, and Jesus encountered in the Sacraments, moves me to discern the will of God. This is the renewal of mind that St. Paul is speaking in the letter to the Romans today. For example, the church preaches the sanctity of all human life from conception to natural death. The faithful take that teaching to heart, to be challenged by it, to see this teaching as truly that of Jesus Christ. Every disciple, everyone who professes faith in the Lord, and all who are incorporated into the Body of Christ through their baptisms are bound to have their hearts and souls formed by the Lord and act accordingly. This is the profound difference between the acts of governments and political systems that force "justice" and the church who seek to form conscience.

LABOR DAY – This weekend is an appropriate time for us to reflect on one of the principals of Catholic Social Teaching, the Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers. The economy must serve people, not the other way around. Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected - the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to the organization and joining of unions, to private property, and to economic initiative.

We know that we are living in a challenging economic environment. Some are unemployed, and many others are underemployed or don't have adequate health care. As a result of the pressures on the employers and the workers, a great deal of rhetoric that is sometimes hateful, and many times insensitive, has occurred in our country. While we continue to work toward answers regarding both what the worker is owed and what the employer can justly pay, it may serve us well to remember the words of St. Paul: "Owe nothing except to love one another."

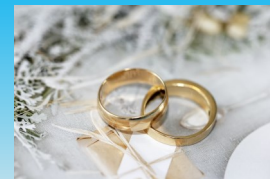

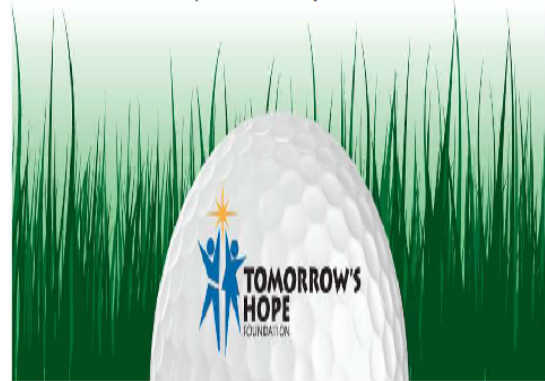

In 1917, Padre Pio made a pilgrimage to the oldest Shrine in Western Europe, dedicated to Saint Michael the Archangel at Monte Sant' Angelo in Gargano (Puglia, Italy). He traveled with other townsfolk from San Giovanni Rotondo to pray to Saint Michael in "the Holy Grotto." On many occasions, Padre Pio would send penitents to the Shrine to pray for the intercession and protection of Saint Michael for the salvation of their souls. He encouraged his spiritual children to have devotion to the Holy Archangel, because "you will need the help of Saint Michael living in this world!"

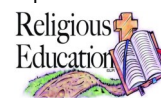




