## ...from Fr. Gerard

*One thing I ask of the LORD; this I seek: To dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life.  
That I may gaze on the loveliness of the LORD and contemplate his temple.*

In the mega musical, *Les Misérables*, the young child, Cosette, labors under her abusive guardians. Rising above her oppressive existence, she sings a hopeful song about a “castle on a cloud.”

*There is a castle on a cloud,  
I like to go there in my sleep,  
Aren't any floors for me to sweep,  
Not in my castle on a cloud.  
I know a place where no one's lost,  
I know a place where no one cries,  
Crying at all is not allowed,  
Not in my castle on a cloud.*

That there is such a place keeps Cosette's hope alive. The dream becomes a reality, however, when Jean Valjean, in fulfillment of his promise to Cosette's mother, rescues Cosette and provides her with such a place and life for the rest of his life. The “castle on a cloud” is not just a fanciful vision in the mind of Cosette; it's a place she knows exists, and she is eventually blessed to dwell within it.

Very often, when we speak of heaven and the eternal life that God has prepared for us, we want to believe it exists, but doubt overshadows that hope. Or perhaps we do believe it exists, but feel it to be so far away that its existence brings little consolation to a current despair. Such a vision is not the one God has for us. Not only is heaven for real, but we can also know and experience its reality even in our earthly life.

When we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord this week, we did not do so with a wishful longing to follow him to where he goes. Rather, we celebrated the Ascension with an acknowledgement of God's eternal kingdom and a desire to direct our lives to the place where God has called us. In addition, we also make the commitment as church, to live in the house of the Lord all our days, here and now. We help each other to encounter Christ and to glimpse the reality of God's house through the living out of our baptismal promises.

It was through our well-founded hope and the fulfillment of baptismal promises that you and I long for and live, not in a “castle on a cloud,” but in the **house of the Lord**.

**HOLY MASS** – In his encyclical, titled *The Church from the Eucharist*, Pope Saint John Paul II wrote about holy mass as the everyday encounter with heaven.

*The Eucharist is truly a glimpse of heaven appearing on earth. It is a glorious ray of the heavenly Jerusalem which pierces the clouds of our history and lights up our journey.*

*Even when it is celebrated on the humble altar of a country church, the Eucharist is always, in some way, celebrated on the altar of the world. It unites heaven and earth.*

The celebration of Holy Mass is a daily opportunity to dwell in the house of the Lord. In addition, time we spend in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament immerses us in the mystical experience of eternal paradise. As we approach summer months and deviations from our normal routine, we are faced with both temptation and opportunity. The temptation to decrease our participation in Sunday Eucharist faces us during summer days. However, these days also provide new opportunities. Perhaps the summer schedule makes you more available to attend daily mass, adoration or even just a short visit to the church. There is something truly special about sitting quietly in the church, with the noise of the outside world fading into the background. I hope that you will continue to encounter Christ and the realities of heaven in your life.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS** – Last weekend, we celebrated the last of our eight celebrations of First Holy Communion. These were truly blessed experiences for the children, their families and for the priests and deacons. I want to express my gratitude to the catechists who helped to form these children in faith and prepared them for their special day. I also thank our Director of Music, John Buckel, and our leaders of song, Matt and Amanda, for sharing their talent and beautiful music. Lastly, I thank our Coordinator of Faith Formation, Grace Rozea, and the members of her staff, Kathy, Karen, Nancy, and Grace, for the labor of love and faith that they gave to these masses and our Faith Formation program.

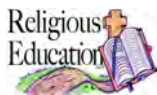
