Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion please remember, you should always be prepared to serve even though you may not be assigned to a Mass, so try to dress accordingly. If you are in 'dress down' mode, please do not come to the altar even if E.M.'s are requested to help.

And with the summer schedules being what they are, lectors should be similarly prepared to serve.
