EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION
REMINDER OF PROPER PROCEDURES

- For those assisting at weekend Masses, I again emphasize, please be faithful to your assigned dates and times.
- Please remember to dress appropriately – if extra ministers are called for at Mass and you are not dressed appropriately, please refrain from assisting.
- At this time, you will not be receiving the Precious Blood until further instructions from the Diocese.
- ***Current Procedure***
 - Ministers must wear masks.
 - As in the past, approach the altar at the 'Lamb of God'.
 - After you receive Holy Communion, purify your hands. (dispenser is in the sacristy) before leaving the sanctuary.
 - Only 6 Extraordinary Ministers will be assigned per Mass. Please note that if a deacon is present, we only need 5 Ministers.
 - The stations are: 3 Ministers at the break – one in the center, one on the Blessed Mother's side and one on the St. Joseph side. Same set-up at the front with the priest, unless a deacon is present, then the Ministers will go to the Blessed Mother's side and St. Joseph side – the deacon remains in the center with the priest.
 - If a congregant wants to receive on the tongue, kindly direct them to the altar rail and the priest or deacon will minister to them at the end of communion.
