# ...from Fr. Gerard

I will make you a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.

Winter blues or depression is understood as part of an affliction called *Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD)* in which people who have normal mental health throughout most of the year experience depressive symptoms in the winter or summer. Those who experience this sort of depression during the winter months are often treated with light therapy. The exposure to light seems to help the afflicted overcome the depressed feelings brought on by the winter season. While recognizing and treating this affliction is relatively new, it seems that light has always been a symbol of hope amid despair.

The words of the prophet Isaiah remind us that we are more than servants of the Lord but called to be a "light" to the nations. In doing so, we are called to reflect Jesus Christ, who is the light of the world, scattering the darkness of sin, despair, and death. I am always appreciative of people who "light up a room" because so often, all we can see is the darkness. Being a light does not mean being oblivious of what is dark. Being light means we see beyond the darkness. I often encourage those who seem to be preoccupied with what is wrong with the church, the world, or our parish community, to see the good and to recognize where there is hope. While the role of the prophet is one that points out the dangers of wayward choices, a prophet is also one who recognizes the abiding presence of the one who comes to obliterate the darkness.

During these winter months let us commit ourselves to being a light that scatters the darkness of hopelessness, fear, and anxiety. Let us help others to recognize what is glorious in the sight of the Lord.

**EAGLE SCOUT PROJECT -** Parishioner Emmet Blaney has been planning his Eagle Scout project, a requirement in achieving the rank of Eagle Scout, for more than a year. The purpose of the project is to give a scout the opportunity to plan, develop, and give leadership to others, through an endeavor that is helpful to a religious institution, school, or community.

To meet these requirements, Emmet offered to build a suitable and appropriate place on our parish grounds for a statue of the Blessed Mother which was donated for the 9-11 Towers of Freedom Memorial in John Burns Park. The statue is placed at the Memorial for the annual 9-11 remembrance, and then returned to storage in the parish. The goal was to provide a permanent public place for the statue which also allows it to be moved once a year.

Emmet had the project, including management plans, approved by his scout troop. He developed contacts to get the materials and professional labor required. He then put together a "work crew' consisting of other scouts. Throughout the course of the project, he developed and honed his communication and organizational skills while dedicating many hours to working through the myriad of issues that are part of any complex construction project.

With Emmet, we thank the following: Tommy Smith for the donation of the Blessed Mother statue; Michael Gentile & Scott Mirsky of Genstar Masonry and Landscaping Design Inc. for the donation of all materials and labor for the statue platform and surrounding patio; Pat Cerda of Cerda Electric for the donation of lighting fixtures and all labor; Costanza Concrete for the donation of materials and the concrete mixer truck; Joe Davis and Sons for landscape planning assistance and the donation of the bushes and flowers; Gregorio's Pizza for the donation of a portion of sales to defray some of the project cost as well as a donation of food for the scouts during the workdays; Joe Quinto, parish Operations Manager for his overall support of the project.

We are very proud of Emmet and grateful to the work and time that he has devoted to St Rose of Lima. He is a fine young man, and we wish him success in his future endeavors.

**CONGRATULATIONS** - I had the honor of offering a blessing and prayer for the newly-inducted Nassau County Legislature including St. Rose of Lima parishioner and catechist, Legislator James D. Kennedy, and my friend, Legislator Rose Marie Walker. St. Rose of Lima is blessed to have several public servants and elected officials as parishioners. We are grateful for their sacrifice and service to our community.






