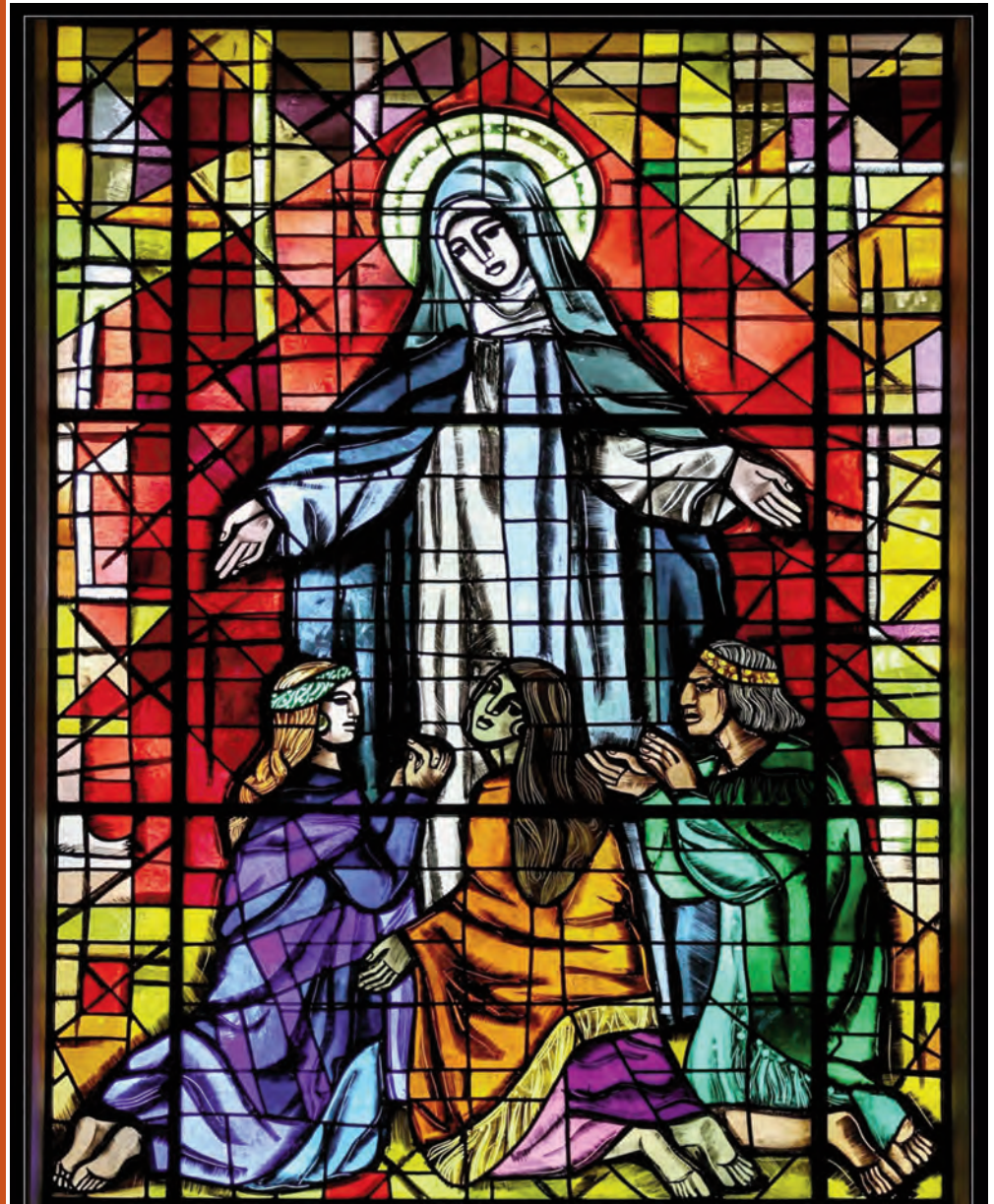

Yet we are courageous, for we walk by faith, not by sight.

I am pretty sure we have all had multiple experiences of something that did not work well in our life. We even go through periods of time when several things are not working well, nothing seems to be going right. These disappointments are so difficult and challenging that it is hard to imagine how we could ever be hopeful. We are tempted to lose courage - to be discouraged - so much so that we can't imagine that God is here or that God cares or is even able to bring change to our situation. We don't know, nor can we foresee, how our disappointment or our sorrow can be transformed. Yet by grace, we continue, and so we are courageous - for we walk by faith, not by sight.

The Latin word *confidere* means "to believe in." Walking in "confidence" is walking "with faith." Amid the most difficult challenges, we can say, "Lord, I know that you know more than I know, and I trust that you alone can redeem the messes and disappointments of life." Knowing that God is with us is half the battle. With that knowledge, my courage and hope are restored. What is walking by faith and not by sight? It is living our lives with an acknowledgement of the presence of God. It is to see beyond discouragement and instead, act with courage, trusting that God sees what I do not.

We are in desperate need of this courage and confidence. On any given day, we are assured of hearing someone speak of how terrible someone or something is. What does that do to our human morale and even our faith? Who are the courageous and confident voices that we are listening to? Are there people in our lives that we admire because of their courage and confidence in the face of adversity? What about the inspiration of heroic saints? We might even look to the young people of our families and communities as examples of courage and confidence. Where we might dismiss a young person's confidence and positive outlook as naïve, we ought to look again and see in them an unadulterated passion for the possible. Courageous and confident faith is all around us. By the grace of the Holy Spirit, may our eyes be opened and our outlook be one of courageous and confident faith.

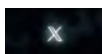

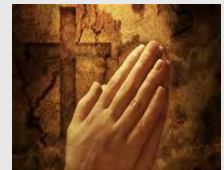

Church Door Renovation Project

We are happy to announce the planned renovation of new doors for our church

As our parish approaches our 75th anniversary, plans to replace our nearly 70 year old doors are underway. Over the last few years, attempts have been made to repair doors that have broken mechanisms and rotting interiors. Replacement parts are hard to come by and the repair of one door alone cost over \$1,000.

Newly designed doors will also allow for increased safety, energy efficiency, and accessibility. Tinted glass windows will bring light into vestibules and allow users to see into and out of the building, increasing safety through greater visibility. The newly designed doors will operate with greater ease and will not be as heavy as the current doors.

The project is scheduled to take place this summer and will cost an estimate of \$90,000.

How Do I Request Prayer for myself or someone I love at St. Rose of Lima?

Our parish receives numerous prayer requests from parishioners, and non-parishioners, for a variety of needs, but mostly for those who are experiencing an illness. Following is a list of opportunities for prayer in our parish:

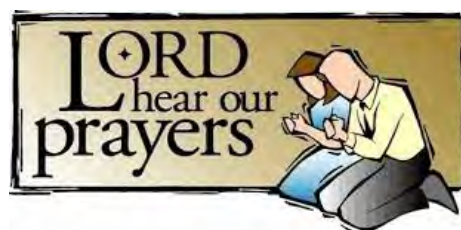
Prayers for the sick from the pulpit and in our weekly bulletin: Please call the rectory (516.798.4992) during regular business hours to add your name to this list. Names are mentioned from the pulpit during all Masses for one week, and are then transferred to the bulletin for a period of three weeks. *(Please note: 1) For privacy reasons, if you are requesting prayers for someone other than yourself, you must have the permission of the person being prayed for to add their name to this list. 2) If a name is not announced, please know that they are not forgotten, as we pray for all those who are ill and convalescing at every Mass).*

Parish Prayer Intention Book: A book is located in the church narthex by the statue of St. Rose of Lima, where you can write your prayer request. These prayers can be for any reason, including for those serving in the military, and will be included collectively in our Sunday and weekday Mass intentions.

Charismatic Prayer Group prayer box: There is a box located on the shelf in the church vestibule - the entrance from the parking lot by the sacristy door - where you can place your request for prayers. Each week, the members of the Charismatic Prayer Group check the box and the prayer requests are divided amongst the members. They will pray for your needs during their meeting on Wednesday afternoons, and continue at their homes. Paper and pencil are available by the prayer box for your convenience.

Prayer Line Ministry: Call or email (mariap@srolchurch.org) the rectory to request prayers. Members of this ministry receive a weekly list of names of people in need of prayer and pray for them in the privacy of their own home. Only first names are used to protect the privacy of the individual being prayed for.

For the Military: Call the rectory to request prayers for those serving in the military and we will print the person's name, and the branch they serve in, in the bulletin on a recurring basis.
