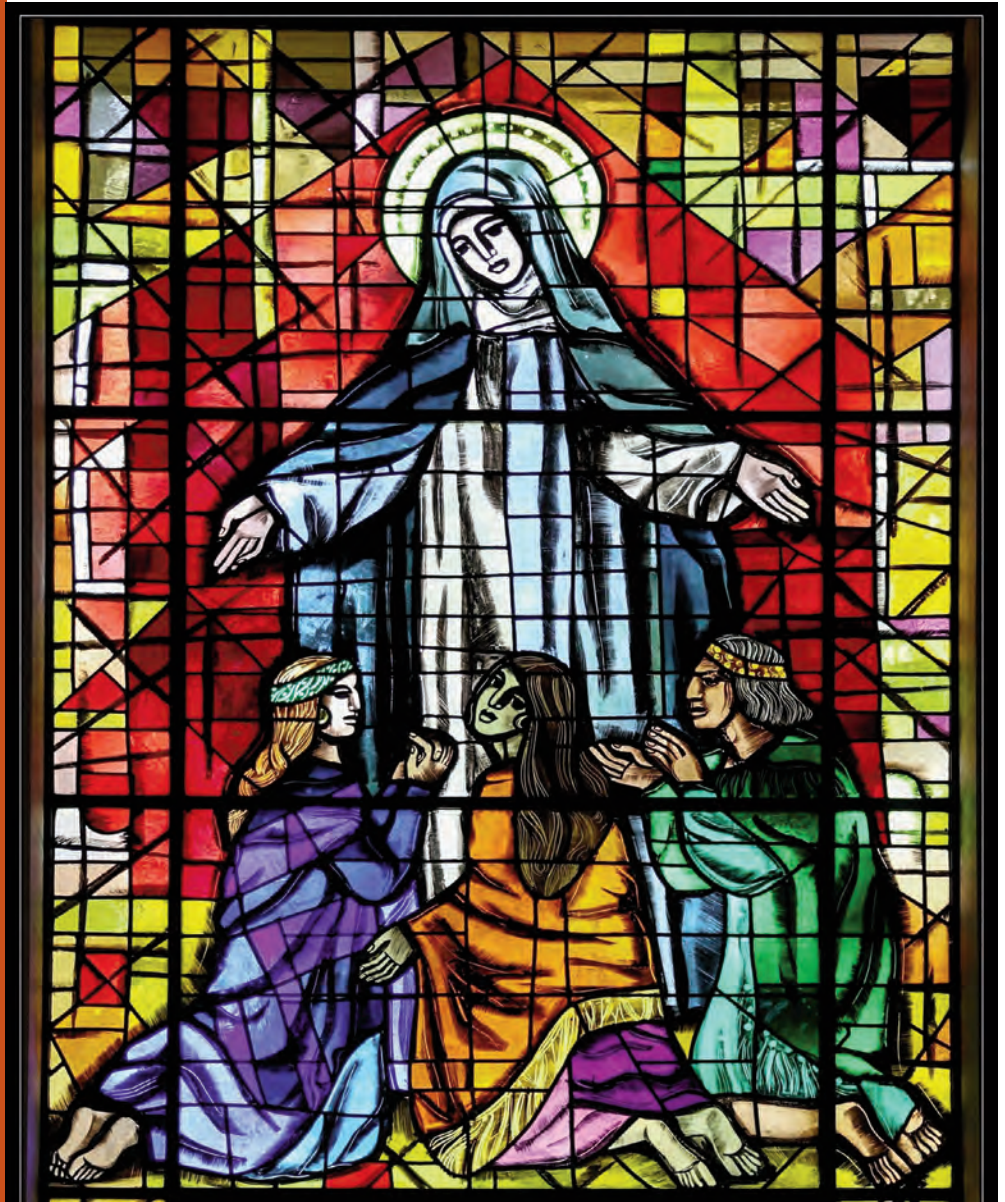

MARRIAGE: Congratulations on your engagement! To begin your journey, please go to the Marriage section of our website (www.srolchurch.org) under Sacraments for full details and a fillable Registration Form used to schedule an appointment with a priest or deacon. No date for a wedding will be set by phone. Couples must make arrangements in person at least six months in advance, and only after all consultations are complete. It is recommended that you set your date with the church before you contract with a caterer.

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (OCIA): Formerly known as RCIA, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults who are not baptized, baptized in another denomination or those who are not fully initiated, become members of the Roman Catholic Church. ...from Fr. Gerard

For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.

We are pulled in many different directions. Our hearts are restless with many different concerns, obligations, and uncertainties. Sometimes though, we are so consumed with the business at hand that we lack self-awareness. We move through life unprepared and unaware of what lies ahead. In the gospel today, our Lord is challenging us to live a life that is not overwhelmed or oblivious but instead, focused on what is most important.

Last weekend, Pope Leo celebrated Holy Mass with young people gathered in Rome for the Jubilee of Youth. He challenged young people, and, therefore, all of us, to examine where our hearts are.

We are not made for a life where everything is taken for granted and static, but for an existence that is constantly renewed through gift of self, in love. This is why we continually aspire to something “more” that no created reality can give us; we feel a deep and burning thirst that no drink in this world can satisfy. Knowing this, let us not deceive our hearts by trying to satisfy them with cheap imitations! Let us rather listen to them! Let us turn this thirst into a step stool, like children who stand on tiptoe, in order to peer through the window of encounter with God. We will then find ourselves before him, who is waiting for us, knocking gently on the window of our soul (cf. Rev 3:20). It is truly beautiful, especially at a young age, to open wide your hearts, to allow him to enter, and to set out on this adventure with him towards eternity.

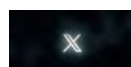
There is a burning question in our hearts, a need for truth that we cannot ignore, which leads us to ask ourselves: what is true happiness? What is the true meaning of life? What can free us from being trapped in meaninglessness, boredom and mediocrity?

We will soon be occupied and preoccupied with the tasks of ordinary life. Let us dedicate some time, therefore, to reflecting on the questions of what we treasure, where we seek happiness and meaning in life, and how we are called to open our hearts so as to not be trapped in meaninglessness, boredom, mediocrity, and that which doesn't give life.

ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY – On Friday, August 15, we celebrate the Solemnity of our Blessed Mother's Assumption into Heaven, body, and soul. This solemnity is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass will be celebrated Thursday, August 14 at 4:00 pm, and Friday, August 15 at 7:30 and 9:00 am and 7:30 pm.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary was declared a dogma of faith by Pope Pius XII who stated, “We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory.” Since Mary is closely associated with all the mysteries of Jesus' life, it is not surprising that the Holy Spirit has led the Church to believe in Mary's share in his glorification. So close was she to Jesus on earth, she must be with him body and soul in heaven.

FEAST OF SAINT ROSE OF LIMA – We will celebrate our parish's patronal feast on Saturday, August 23. Following the 5:15 mass, we will enjoy a parking lot party with burgers, hot dogs and family fun. 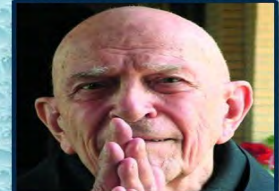
Our next gathering of the *Centering Prayer Group* will take place on Thursday, August 14th. This is in addition to the two Thursday afternoon monthly meetings.

As defined by Fr. Thomas Keating, Centering Prayer follows these four simple steps:

1. Choose a sacred word as a symbol of your intention to consent to God's presence.
2. Sit comfortably, close your eyes, and silently introduce the sacred word.
3. When distracted by thoughts, gently return to the sacred word.
4. At the end of prayer, remain in silence with eyes closed for a couple of minutes.

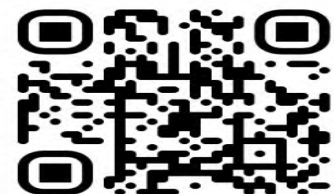

How Do I Request Prayer for myself or someone I love at St. Rose of Lima?

Our parish receives numerous prayer requests from parishioners and non-parishioners, for a variety of needs, but mostly for those who are experiencing an illness. Following is a list of opportunities for prayer in our parish:

Prayers for the sick from the pulpit and in our weekly bulletin: Please call the rectory during regular business hours (516-798-4992) to add your name to this list. Names are mentioned from the pulpit during all Masses for one week, and are then transferred to the bulletin for a period of three weeks. *(Please note: 1) For privacy reasons, if you are requesting prayers for someone other than yourself, you must have the permission of the person being prayed for to add their name to this list. 2) If a name is not announced, please know that they are not forgotten, as we pray for all those who are ill and convalescing at every Mass.)*

Parish Prayer Intention Book: A book is located in the church narthex by the statue of St. Rose of Lima, where you can write your prayer request. These prayers can be for any reason, including for those serving in the military, and will be included collectively in our Sunday and weekday Mass intentions.

Charismatic Prayer Group prayer box: There is a box located on the shelf in the church vestibule - the entrance from the parking lot by the sacristy door - where you can place your request for prayers. Each week, the members of the Charismatic Prayer Group check the box, and the prayer requests are divided amongst the members. They will pray for your needs during their meeting on Wednesday afternoons, and continue at their homes. Paper and pencil are available by the prayer box for your convenience.

Prayer Line Ministry: Call or email (mariap@srolchurch.org) the rectory to request prayers. Members of this ministry receive a weekly list of names of people in need of prayer and pray for them in the privacy of their own home. Only first names are used to protect the privacy of the individual being prayed for.

For the Military: Call the rectory to request prayers for those serving in the military, and we will print the person's name and the branch they serve in, in the bulletin on a recurring basis.
