...from Fr. Gerard

O my people, I will open your graves and have you rise from them and bring you back to the land of Israel.

I have been thinking of Eddie a lot lately. He has even entered my dreams on a more frequent basis. We met in our freshman year of college, became roommates, and remained best friends for over 34 years. After a few years of health challenges uncommon to people our age, Eddie suddenly passed away. Even though he had his job and his family and I was living the active ministry of a priest, we connected continually throughout the week via text messages and phone calls. Suddenly that connection was no longer there. He passed away in November of 2020 while the Covid pandemic was still very much a preoccupation. Within a few short months, I was made aware of my assignment here to St. Rose, and I became immersed in this new life. I was deeply saddened by his death, but with the passing of time, I seemed to miss him less. Why then, all of a sudden, am I thinking about him again? Why is that feeling of sorrow renewed? After more than five years, I unexpectedly have a longing for him to come back. The sorrow we feel when a loved one dies is different than the sorrow we contend with years later. We may have accepted the reality that they are no longer part of our daily life, but the space created by their absence is never quite filled. This is the life of those who are widowed and anyone who has lost a child, a parent, a sibling, or a best friend. We want the Lord to bring them back.

Our Christian faith, however, calls us to live differently. The words of the prophet Ezekiel are not about bringing the dead back to us, but bringing *us* - to eternal life - bringing us out of the finite world to live eternally with the Lord and the great cloud of witnesses that have gone before us.

I can remember as a child being scared by the idea of heaven because I could not grasp what eternity was. I could not wrap my mind around what it meant to experience something that never ended. What I have come to realize though is that I have experienced moments of joy and contentment that I wished would not end. In our imperfect humanity we have accepted the concept that “all good things must come to an end.” However, our faith offers us something different, a goodness that never ends. What that feels like I do not know. I do know that I will die, and I know that Jesus Christ is the resurrection and the life. What I long for is more than a restoration of what I knew, but instead a reunion with the faithfully departed and the Lord in a way that is beyond my imagination.

We pray for those who have gone before us, and we live our lives today in the pursuit of holiness and divine mercy.

LITURGICAL MINISTER TRAINING – During the month of April, the Diocese of Rockville Centre will offer training for those who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors. **Part A** is the “BASIC” training that is required for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend **Part B** training in May in addition to BASIC training. One must attend Part A training prior to Part B training. A Lector Workshop is available for both new and experienced lectors.


St. Rose of Lima Respect Life Committee Lent 2026

Did you know? You can use your IRA to make a meaningful gift to our Church and potentially lower your taxes!

What is a Qualified Charitable Donation (QCD)?

A direct transfer of funds from your IRA to a qualified charity (like us!). Available to those age 70½ or older.

Key Benefits:

Counts Toward RMD: Satisfies your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) for the year.

Reduces Taxable Income: Lowers your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI).

No Itemizing Needed: You don't need to itemize deductions to benefit.

Tax-Free: The gift is tax-free for you.

Quick Facts for 2026:

Limit: Up to \$111,000 per person.

Deadline: December 31st.

Must go directly from your IRA custodian to the charity.

How to Give via QCD:

Contact Your IRA Custodian: Ask them to send the funds directly to your parish or Diocese and mention it's for a QCD.

The Federal Scholarship Tax Credit: Support Students at No Cost to You

Starting **January 1, 2027**, a new federal law provides an historic opportunity to support Catholic education by redirecting a portion of your federal taxes directly to student scholarships.

What is it and how does it work?

- **Dollar-for-Dollar Credit:** This is a **100% tax credit**, not just a deduction. For every dollar you contribute to a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO), your federal tax bill is reduced by that same amount.
- **Credit Limits:** Every individual who pays federal tax can receive a credit of up to **\$1,700** (or **\$3,400 for married couples** filing jointly).
- **No Out-of-Pocket Cost:** Because the contribution reduces your tax liability dollar-for-dollar, you are simply "redirecting" money you already owe the IRS to support local students.
- **Generous Eligibility:** Scholarships serve students from households with an income up to **300% of their county's median income**.

An Urgent Call to Action: Contact Governor Hochul

For families to benefit from this program, the State of New York must "opt-in". Visit <https://bit.ly/2026FSTC> to contact Governor Hochul and urge her to opt-in to the FSTC.

- **Annual Requirement:** The state's participation is not permanent; the Governor must choose to opt-in on an **annual basis**.
- **Urgent Advocacy:** It is critical that we contact Governor Hochul now to urge her to opt-in for the 2027 tax year.
- **Keeping Dollars in New York:** If New York does not opt-in, donations from New Yorkers can still be made to SGOs in other states, meaning our tax dollars would leave New York to support students elsewhere.

How to Support Long Island's Catholic Schools

While federal law prevents donors from directing a scholarship to a *specific child*, you have the power to choose which community benefits:

- **Designate Our School:** When you contribute, you can direct the SGO to send your donation to a **specific diocese or even a specific school**.
Timeline: The credit becomes claimable for the **2027 tax year** (filed in 2028).

This is a "win-win" for our families and parish communities. By contacting Governor Hochul and participating in this program, you can ensure your tax dollars stay local to support a child's Catholic education.
