...from Fr. Gerard

"The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groanings."

There are moments in every Christian's life when words fail us. Grief, uncertainty, or heavy burdens can leave us feeling incapable of even finding words for prayer. Yet Paul reminds us that our inability to find the right words is not a failure. It is precisely in our weakness that the Holy Spirit goes to work. The Spirit prays within us, carrying before the Father the deepest desires of our hearts, even those we cannot fully understand ourselves.

Pope St. John Paul II captured this truth when asked, "How does the Pope pray?" He replied, "You would have to ask the Holy Spirit! The Pope prays as the Holy Spirit permits him to pray." Even the Successor of St. Peter recognized that authentic prayer is not first about eloquence or technique, but about surrendering to the work of the Holy Spirit.

This should give us confidence. God does not expect perfect prayers; He desires open hearts. Whether our prayer is filled with beautiful words, silent tears, or simply a longing to be near Him, the Holy Spirit is already at work, transforming our weakness into a prayer pleasing to the Father. The greatest prayer may simply be to place ourselves before God and allow the Spirit to pray within us.

SUMMER FAMILY FESTIVAL – One of the most special weeks of the year is upon us. The Annual Family Festival is a time of making memories and building community. This year's Festival brings back the Town of Oyster Bay Showmobile where local entertainment will be featured. This is one way in which we hope to recapture the experience of community and belonging. While the Festival is a vital fundraiser for our school, its most significant purpose has always been to enjoy each other and the community that we live in. It is a time to watch our children become adults and those adults become parents who share these days with their children. It is my prayer that these days will be joyful and invigorating. I hope that they will set the tone of our yearlong celebration of our parish's 75th Anniversary.

As I said a few weeks ago, we are hopeful that our shortened schedule will help to lessen the impact that the Festival has on the neighborhood residents and businesses. All who attend the Festival can help to make the event one that is not disruptive to that surrounding the church. Your cooperation with neighborhood parking regulations is greatly appreciated. In addition, we ask that parents of adolescence and teens either accompany their children or inform them that they are to enjoy the Festival and act respectfully on parish property and the neighborhood.

ANNIVERSARY PLANNING – I want to offer you a brief update on our plans for the celebration of our 75th Anniversary of our parish in November of 2027. A steering committee met with me recently, and we identified two clear priorities for the anniversary year; celebrate and preserve the history of St. Rose of Lima and plan a meaningful anniversary event each month throughout the celebration year. Names are mentioned from the pulpit during all Masses for one week, and are then transferred to the bulletin for a period of three weeks. *(Please note: 1) For privacy reasons, if you are requesting prayers for someone other than yourself, you must have the permission of the person being prayed for to add their name to this list. 2) If a name is not announced, please know that they are not forgotten, as we pray for all those who are ill and convalescing at every Mass.)*

Parish Prayer Intention Book: A book is located in the church narthex by the statue of St. Rose of Lima, where you can write your prayer request. These prayers can be for any reason, including for those serving in the military, and will be included collectively in our Sunday and weekday Mass intentions.

Charismatic Prayer Group prayer box: There is a box located on the shelf in the church vestibule - the entrance from the parking lot by the sacristy door - where you can place your request for prayers. Each week, the members of the Charismatic Prayer Group check the box, and the prayer requests are divided amongst the members. They will pray for your needs during their meeting on Wednesday afternoons, and continue at their homes. Paper and pencil are available by the prayer box for your convenience.

Prayer Line Ministry: Call or email (mariap@srolchurch.org) the rectory to request prayers. Members of this ministry receive a weekly list of names of people in need of prayer and pray for them in the privacy of their own home. Only first names are used to protect the privacy of the individual being prayed for.

For the Military: Call the rectory to request prayers for those serving in the military, and we will print the person's name and the branch they serve in, in the bulletin on a recurring basis.

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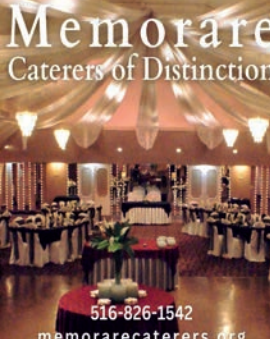
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
