...from Fr. Gerard

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net thrown into the sea, which collects fish of every kind. When it is full, they haul it ashore and sit down to put what is good into buckets. What is bad, they throw away.

In today's Gospel, Jesus offers a series of brief parables that invite us to recognize what is truly valuable and to develop the wisdom to distinguish what leads to life from what leads us away from God. The final image—the net gathering fish of every kind before the good are separated from the bad—reminds us that discernment is an essential part of the Christian life.

Every day we are faced with choices. Some are obvious, while others are far more subtle. Evil often disguises itself as convenience, popularity, or self-interest. Goodness, on the other hand, frequently requires patience, humility, forgiveness, and sacrifice. The disciple of Christ is called to look beyond appearances and ask: Does this thought, word, or action draw me closer to Christ and help me love God and my neighbor?

Yet Jesus' teaching is not an invitation to become harsh judges of others. We are called first to examine our own hearts. When we encounter evil—in ourselves or in the world—we are not to respond with hatred, revenge, or contempt. We are called to respond as Christ did: with truth spoken in love, mercy that seeks conversion, courage that refuses to compromise, and hope that never gives up on the possibility of redemption.

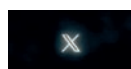
To discern well, we must remain close to the Lord through prayer, the Scriptures, and the sacraments. The more our hearts are conformed to Christ, the more readily we recognize the difference between good and evil, and the more naturally we respond with His compassion, patience, and justice.

May we treasure the Kingdom above all else, seek the wisdom that comes from God, and reflect Christ in every choice we make.
